

Charles Fackler Obituary

harles "Pete" H. Fackler, III peacefully went home to be with his Lord and Savior, Jesus Christ, on Thursday, August 31, 2023. He was born on May 30, 1935, in Harrisburg, to the late Earl and Catherine Fackler. Charles was the husband of the late Richenda D. (Hauer) Fackler. He was a loving husband, father, grandfather and great-grandfather, a charter member of Community Evangelical Free Church, former teacher, coach and principal at Susquehanna High School, former principal at Hershey High School and Harrisburg Christian School, former member and executive director of PIAA, and inductee into the PA Sports Hall of Fame. He also attained rank of Staff Sergeant in the PA National Guard before being honorably discharged in 1964.




