SOUTH BEND - David Clark Isele, composer, singer, organist and the Notre Dame Glee Club from 1973-1979, has died in Tampa, F joined the faculty of the Department of Music at Notre Dame at the Prof. Daniel H. Pedtke who directed the Glee Club from 1938-197

Dr. Isele graduated from Oberlin College and completed his doctorate at the Earmaster's degrees in organ at Southern Methodist University. Known to his stude figure at the University. Since formerly all-male Notre Dame had recently begun created a mixed chorus which he directed as well as the Glee Club. He made ur Glee Club's favorite pieces such as the Alma Mater, Notre Dame Our Mother, ar currently still in use.

With his colleague, Sue Seid Martin, he also served as organist and choir direct Sacred Heart, and like Bach, often wrote new Masses, psalms and antiphons fo sung in parishes all over the nation. He traveled extensively with both the Glee (United States, and twice to Europe.

In 1980 Isele joined the University of Tampa, Florida, as professor of music and serving as organist and music minister at Sacred Heart Church in Tampa. Even he continued to compose for choruses and solo performers in many different ve

Most recently, Isele returned to South Bend in October, 2015 for the celebration of the Notre Dame Glee Club, conducting a number of songs with the returnees with the whole group of more than 500 singers who returned for the reunion, in a Auditorium.
