And then I remember and remember I will

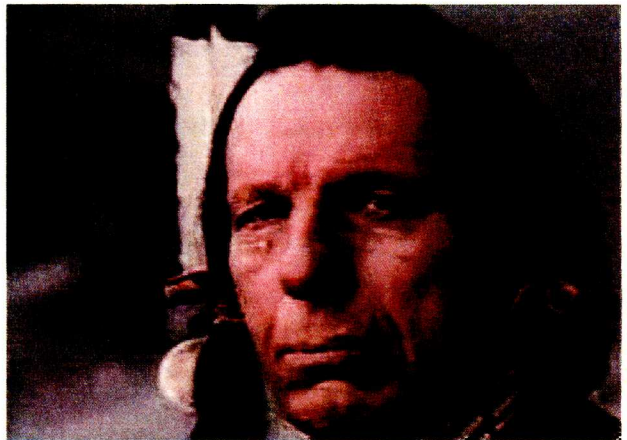
Where are you now? Are you far, are you near?
