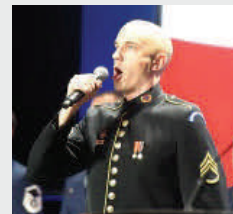

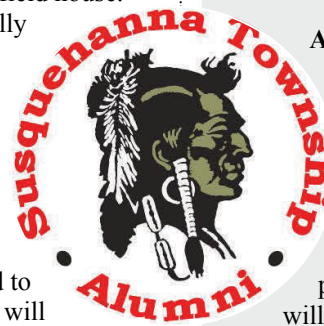

We are pleased to share that the Susquehanna Township School District has chosen an outstanding alumnus to deliver this year's Commencement keynote address.

The district's announcement reads in part:

Miriam Marguerita Gomez Witmer, Ph.D., an award-winning educator, mental health provider, and mentor with a passion for teaching, consulting, and speaking will provide the keynote address at Commencement Exercises for the Susquehanna Twp. High School Class of 2016, at 7:30 p.m. on June 9, at the Farm Show Complex in the Large Arena.



Dr. Witmer graduated from STHS in 1979, and earned her B.S. in English Education/Communications and a Masters in Clinical Psychology from Millersville University. She earned her doctorate in Education with an expertise in Educational Psychology from Temple University. Her most recent published research is entitled, *Ethnically diverse education students' perceptions of mentoring: Implications for college success and career aspirations.*

Dr. Witmer was a high school English teacher for 16 years and she was named the Lampeter-Strasburg School District's Outstanding Teacher of the Year in 1995. She was also honored as a National Outstanding Educator and Phi Delta Kappa Distinguished Educator. In 2008, she was named Millersville University's MMAP Outstanding Mentor of the Year.....

She has experience teaching graduate and undergraduate courses in educational psychology, issues in secondary education, instructional technology, and mentoring student teachers. For the past ten years she has also coordinated a mentoring program and facilitated in-school college readiness seminars to support urban middle school and high school students' desires to attend college.....

She has presented at a variety of conferences including the American Educational Research Association, the Association of Teacher Educators, Pennsylvania Association of Colleges for Teacher Education, PA chapter and the National Association of Multicultural Education, the National Black Graduate Student Association, the International Mentoring Association, the American Association of Colleges for Teacher Education, and the National Great Schools Summit. She has published an article entitled, *The Fourth R in education-Relationships in the May/June 2005 issue of The Clearing House.*

Dedicated to community service, Dr. Witmer is president of Celebration for Life, Inc., a non-profit fundraising organization supporting cancer patients and their families. Since 2000, this organization has donated more than \$250,000 to support cancer education, research and support services with a bulk of the funds helping students with cancer attend Camp Can Do Forever. She also serves on a number of local school district committees, including the Occupational Advisory Committee for the School District of Lancaster. She also is a member of the Dual Enrollment and the Technology committees for the Solanco School District.

The Dauphin County Commissioners did not approve our \$20,000 Gaming Grant request. We will be able to resubmit this month. Shortly, the Vietnam Memorial Committee will announce plans for additional fundraising efforts to enable us to remain on track for a 2017 installation. It is estimated the total costs to construct our third memorial will reach \$60,000. Currently there is just under \$30,000 allocated to the project.

As a reminder, the memorial will contain names of STHS alumni or veterans who lived in the township and served in the military during the Vietnam Conflict era from February 28, 1961 to May 7, 1975.

We currently have 250 names. Keep them coming!
